Over the course of the next three years public education will be experiencing numerous changes regarding the curriculum that will be taught in schools. In June 2010, the State Board of Education adopted the Common Core Standards in English language arts and mathematics as well as the revisions to Ohio's academic content standards in science and social studies. The standards will be effective in 2014-2015 when newly aligned assessments will be implemented. These standards are internationally benchmarked and designed to provide students the foundation necessary for success in college and in the workforce.

The new assessments which will be implemented set the bar higher for students on the knowledge needed to compete internationally. In addition, they will compare performance with other states and countries, provide data to educators and parents to support instruction and allow early intervention for students who need extra help.

According to the Ohio Board of Regents, even though more than half of our school districts have attained ratings of 'Excellent' 41% of students who graduate from a public school in Ohio take at least one remedial course when they enroll in one of the state's two or four year public institutions.

This information prompted New Riegel to conduct a survey of the graduates of 2010 and 2011 of which 25/64 have been completed and returned. In the survey we asked alumni: If you went to college did you have to take any remediation courses? We defined this as any course in which they had to take a lower level because they did not test into the level they needed to complete a course requirement for their major. Of the surveys returned by students who are currently attending college, four stated they did have to take a lower level course.

Additionally, we asked students if they felt prepared for the ACT/SAT and how we could have better prepared them for the test. 16/23 indicated they did feel prepared. We surveyed students for their input on the academic strengths and weaknesses of the educational program, and how New Riegel could improve in helping students be better prepared for life after high school. The honest responses the recent alumni have provided will be shared with the staff and used to improve the academic offerings of the district.

If you are an alumnus and have not yet completed your survey, I encourage you to do so as your input is valued. If you are an alumni prior to the class of 2010 and would like to complete a survey, please contact me and I will see that one is mailed to you.

We continually strive to make receiving a New Riegel High School diploma meaningful by graduating every student college and career ready.

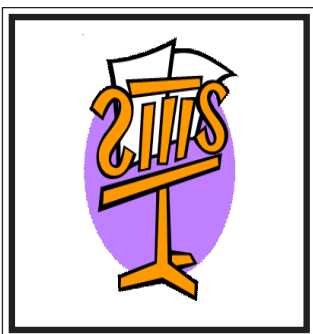
MUSIC NOTES...

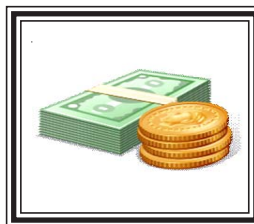

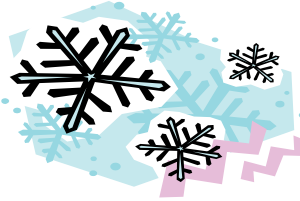
