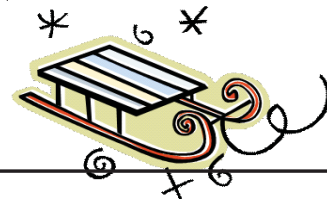

I would like to extend a Happy New Year to everyone in the New Riegel community. I hope everyone had a safe and enjoyable holiday season. The time off from school for our students hopefully has provided an opportunity to spend time with family and recharge their battery for the upcoming semester. Classes resume January 3rd. Our first semester will conclude on January 13th for all students K-12. Students in grades 7-12 will wrap up the semester with exams on Thursday, January 12th and Friday, January 13th. All grades 7-12 will be taking exams during these days.



On behalf of the staff, I would like to thank the PTO for the fantastic dinner they provided during teacher conferences. I would also like to thank all the parents who have contributed their time to volunteer in the classroom, assist in the Christmas bazaar, provide food for conferences, volunteer for scholastic book sales, use the multiple vendors attached to our school for fundraisers. Between the PTO and Academic Booster groups our teachers received multiple mini grants to help with assemblies, additional books and supplies for students and prizes for our three positive behavior programs. Thank you!

An updated course description booklet will be available to parents at the end of January. Currently, we are working with the teaching staff to update descriptions and course requirements for the 12-13 school year. We will follow the same procedures for scheduling as we did last spring. Students will receive the booklet in an orientation session at school. Each grade will be given key items to remember when requesting courses. Students will use the worksheet provided to discuss with parents courses they would want to schedule.

In mid February, students will be requesting courses on line during the school day with our counselor. Each grade will be given specific instructions on course selections. After the course requests have been made the master schedule will be created to meet the needs of student/parent selections for courses. A schedule will be sent home in March for parent review and signature. This is an important step in the process as it bridges the gap between home and school. Parents are encouraged to ask questions to clarify schedules and possibly to change courses selected.

FAFSA

Seniors and parents can begin to complete the **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** on January 1st. The web site is <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov>.

We all know college is expensive! The FAFSA is the first step to financing college. Seniors should have applied and been accepted to their colleges by the time they complete the FAFSA. I encourage you to send your FAFSA results to **every** school you are interested in. The colleges will use the FAFSA information to create your personalized financial aid package. **Please pay close attention to priority deadlines.** You may need to file your taxes earlier than previous years. Keep in mind you can complete the FAFSA based on projected amounts and then file a correction once you have filed. You will need to work one-on-one with each college about financial decisions!

All sophomores took the Plan test on November 16th. Results were given out in December. Please share this information.

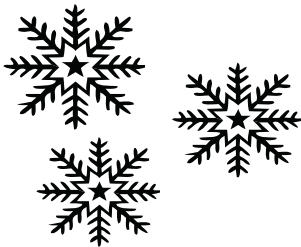
