Helping Children Succeed in School

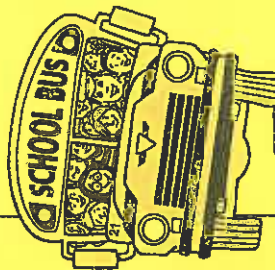
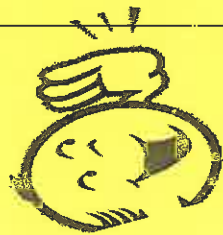
This class helps parents explore ways in which they can help their children do their best in school. Topics will include homework help, parents participation with schools and student social skills.

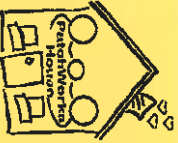
