

New Riegel Local Board of Education
Regular Meeting Minutes
May 9, 2022

Meeting was called to order by President Beth Kummerer.

The following members were present: Angel Bodart, Jeff Hohman, and Beth Kummerer. Rodney Biggert and Jaclyn Schalk were absent.

Treasurer Jane Schalk reported 1st quarter income tax received in April was \$240,566. She also reported on Rover Pipeline tax revenue and the potential appeal value of the pipeline. A review of the five-year forecast to be submitted to the Ohio Department of Education in May was conducted.

5-12 Principal Justin Johnson updated the Board on several end of the year items including prom, academic honors breakfast, spring music performances and graduation. He reviewed proposed changes to the student handbook for next school year including weighted grades for CCP classes and a small change in the dress code.
