

**New Riegel Local Board of Education
Regular Meeting Minutes
September 12, 2022**

Meeting was called to order by President Beth Kummerer.

The following members were present: Rodney Biggert, Angel Bodart, Jeff Hohman and Beth Kummerer. Jaclyn Schalk was absent.

Treasurer Jane Schalk reported that the district has received our 2022 – 2nd half real estate tax settlement. The 2nd half gross general fund collections were \$452,277. Mrs. Schalk also reported that the district received our 1st of two semi-annual fiscal year casino tax payments in the amount of \$12,052. We were also informed that the state auditors will be starting their bi-annual audit (FY21 and FY22) within one to two weeks.

Middle and High School Principal Justin Johnson noted the book study focus for this year for the 6-12 staff will be focusing on strategies for motivating disengaged students. Mr. Johnson also reported on the middle school teachers introducing the SEAL program. In addition, discussions have begun around the development of the high school PBIS program.

Superintendent David Rombach reported on a safety grant procurement process. Quotes for all projects are almost complete and the grant application is due by October 3rd. The safety glass is being installed this week to all of the exterior doors. Mr. Rombach also updated the Board about the long jump pit being updated and that we are still waiting on the track building design and quote.

WHEREAS, the New Riegel School District Board of Education (“Board of Education”) anticipates that the District may experience difficulty obtaining substitute teachers during the 2022-2023 school year; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to authority granted in Section 4 of Senate Bill 1, which was enacted by the 134th General Assembly and became effective as an emergency measure on October 28, 2021, the Board of Education was authorized to establish its own education requirements for individuals to serve as substitute teachers in the District during the 2021-2022 school year; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly has extended this authority for the 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 school years through enactment of House Bill 583; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education desires to temporarily adopt modified education requirements for substitute teachers in accordance with the law during the 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 school years as a measure to help ensure availability of a sufficient number of substitute teachers.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the New Riegel School District Board of Education as follows:

SECTION I

The Board of Education temporarily authorizes the employment of substitute teachers who do not hold post-secondary degrees, as is otherwise required pursuant to Ohio law and regulations, including Ohio Revised Code 3319.226 and 3319.30, Ohio Administrative Code Section 3301-23-44, and/or Board Policy 3120.04 - Employment of Substitutes, during the 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 school years. In addition to fulfilling the educational requirements adopted by the Board of Education, an individual must be of good moral character and must have completed all required criminal background checks, as well as obtained a valid non-renewable temporary substitute teaching license issued by the Ohio Department of Education to serve as a substitute teacher in the District.
